

Greetings from Jackson Center Schools!

Events:

Unfortunately, tickets for remaining indoor events at Jackson Center Schools will probably be limited for the rest of the year. However, if you have not been able to attend an event involving our students or watch them online, I would like to personally invite you to either attend in person or tune into a live stream channel and watch a basketball tournament game, the spring musical "Little Women" or any number of events that are happening this spring. You will be impressed and walk away proud to be a Tiger!

School Safety:

The end of January and beginning of February has given us the gift of some nice snow falls. As a reminder, we will delay or cancel school if conditions are treacherous on our school district roads. Our main concern is young drivers and our busses. Most adults have enough experience driving in hazardous conditions, but many of our 16 and 17 year olds do not always take their time and use their proper precautions. Our busses are also a concern because of the number of stops and starts they make during their routes. Sliding is an issue for them as well as the people around them. There is no exact science to calling a delay or cancellation, but we do work with the other local school districts and try to make the best call possible.

If we were to exceed our 5 "normal" snow days and do not have a chance to make them up, we will use online schooling (remote) days similar to last spring. I will communicate further and with more detail if that time arises.

We are looking at a great deal of snow right now, but as the weather changes and more students walk or ride their bikes, it is a great time to remember that all of us need to slow down and follow all school guidelines at the beginning and end of the school day. **All parents dropping off or picking up their students at school need to use the curb lane!**

Dropping off between cars or in the parking lanes is very dangerous for the students because they cannot always be seen clearly by other drivers. The only exception would be if an adult needs to walk their student to the door. In that case, the children need to stay with that adult. After school, if you are in the curb lane, please stay in your car and have your student look for you so the traffic keeps moving. Thank you for continuing to follow these simple guidelines and keep our kids safe.

In addition, we will have a new member of our educational team sometime close to the end of February. Thanks to a grant from Airstream, 'Goose' will be "working" at school each day. 'Goose' is a trained therapy dog and will also have skills in drug detection. 'Goose' will work with the entire student population, but will probably spend much of his day with our students with special needs. They will learn to take care of him and he will help them with some of the difficulties they face through the day.

Save the Date:

Friday, April 30th will be a professional development day for staff. No school for students!


