COMMUNITY

Jackson Center is a small town with a population of 1400 located in northeastern Shelby County, in West Central Ohio. The town is located on St. Rt. 65, which runs north and south and St. Rt. 274, which runs east and west. Interstate 75 is 8 miles to the west and U.S. Rt. 33 is 10 miles to the east. Although located in a rural area, the village has a great deal of industry including Airstream, Plastipak Packaging, Lacal and EMI. The business section of town features a pharmacy, bank, post office, and movie theatre.

SCHOOL

TYPE: 4 year public with college preparatory as well as vocational curriculum. Juniors and seniors can attend the Upper Valley Career Center. The building also includes grades 6, 7 and 8.
