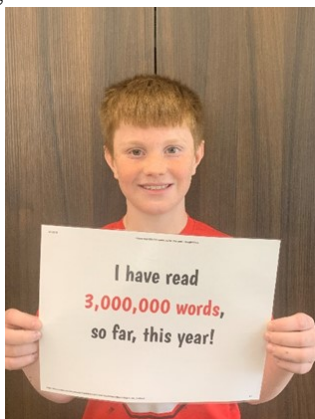

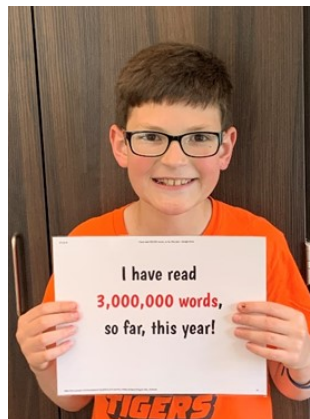

There are two options for those that paid a Chromebook deposit during the 2023-2024 school year.

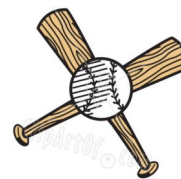
- 1) You can have the deposit rolled over to the 2024-2025 school year for use of a school Chromebook.

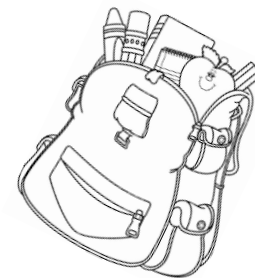
