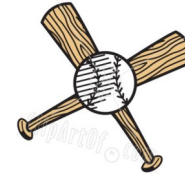
Our Word Count Chart is located in the Elementary wing, second floor, if you would like to see how hard our students have worked this year.

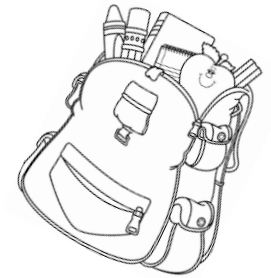
