# **College Application Options:**

<u>Early Decision:</u> Under this admissions program, you agree to attend this school if accepted, and you can't apply to any other college or university. It is binding. Be careful of this option.

<u>Early Action</u>: Like early decision, you are applying only to your top-choice school. However, unlike early decision, you are not bound to attend if accepted and you can apply early action to more than one university.

<u>Regular Admissions</u>: All students must submit their applications by a specific date, usually between November and January.

<u>Rolling Admissions</u>: Common at large state universities, schools that provide rolling admissions allow students to apply at any time during their admissions period; typically, September through July.
