<u>Early Decision:</u> Under this admissions program, you agree to attend this school if accepted, and you can't apply to any other college or university. It is binding. Be careful of this option.

<u>Early Action</u>: Unlike early decision, you are not bound to attend if accepted and you can apply early action to more than one university. Early deadlines.

<u>Regular Admissions</u>: Submit applications by a certain deadline.

<u>Rolling Admissions</u>: Apply at any time during their admissions period; typically, September through July.
