Minutes from the Regular Meeting on Oct. 29th, 2020 - Res. #20-102

Mr. Ware moved and Mrs. Davis seconded a motion to approve the minutes from the Regular meeting held on October 29th, 2020. Roll call – 5-0. Motion carried.
